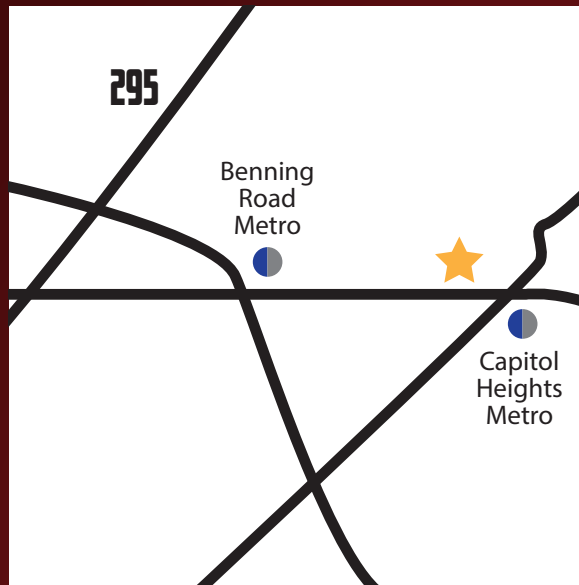

An HBI Pre-Apprenticeship Certificate Training (PACT) is an industry-recognized certification that will give you entry-level skills in carpentry, plumbing, and electrical among many others. Alumni from the program have gone on to intern and work for Forrester Construction and the Department of General Services.

WORKFORCE TRAINING

Connecting with employers throughout the city, Maya Angelou YALC offers students opportunities to gain hands-on, paid work experience while attending classes. Our partnerships with the Department of Public Works (DPW), Department of Employment Services (DOES), Metro, and Urban Alliance position students for success upon completion of their G.E.D.

COMMUNICATIONS CABLING

Our new program, Communications Cabling, is a six to eight week course that teaches students how to install and troubleshoot copper low voltage wiring for jobs in the cable, home security, and smart home technology fields. At the end of the course, students will receive a C-tech certificate, one of the top credentials in the cabling field.



GED ACADEMIC CLASSES

You have the option to attend a daily 3-hour course in the morning or afternoon. All of our instructors are highly trained educators and our classes are small. This means that you are getting individualized instruction in subjects such as language arts, social studies, science and math, all with an emphasis on important critical thinking skills.
